8/21/12	Can you tell me how much of the original grant is available? As of what date?	As of July 1, 2012, the available balance of the grant is \$41,213.76.
8/24/12	You stated the budget as of July 1, 2012 is \$41,213.76. Should the budget for the RFP reflect that amount?	You may use the \$41,213.76 figure when answering questions pertaining to the program budget portion of Attachment 6 (Proposal Requirements).
8/27/12	You stated the budget as of July 1, 2012 is \$41,213.76. The last vendor for this grant provided visitation services until August 15, 2012. Does the court still need to reimburse the previous vendor therefore that amount would be deducted from the \$41,213.76. If so on average the previous vendor on billed out about \$6,000.00 a month. Therefore would the awarded amount be reduced by approximately \$9,000.00? If so, what award number should the budget reflect for the RFP?	You are correct; the final award amount is dependent upon the receipt, review, and approval of the final invoices from the previous vendor. As the invoice amounts may vary depending on the number of clients that are referred to these services, a precise award figure is unattainable at this stage in the RFP process. Discussions involving final budgetary figures will be discussed with the successful proposer. Given the unknown final amount of the award at the present time, proposers are allowed to submit an estimated program budget for the purposes of answering the budgetary questions in Attachment 6.
