ORDER GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE
BUTTE COUNTY SHERIFF TO IMPLEMENT
THE EMERGENCY BAIL SCHEDULE

10
11 **I.**
12 **FINDINGS**

13 As of the date of this order, Butte County reports 758 COVID-19 total cases, of which 420 are
14 new cases within the last 14 days. On July 22, 2020, Butte County was placed on a 3-day state
15 Monitoring List with the expectation to be placed on increased restriction throughout the county.
16 According to the Office of the Governor and the California Department of Public Health, certain data
17 metrics reflect whether a county is placed on the Monitoring List. And, being placed on the list is a
reflection of a dangerous spread of coronavirus.

18 One such metric is whether the county has a case rate of greater than 100 per 100,000 residents
19 as it is evidence of an elevated disease transmission rate. Currently, Butte County's case rate is 189 per
20 100,000 residents, reflecting an elevated rate of disease transmission. The rate of infection is 1.39.
21 Testing in Butte County currently shows a positivity rate of 7.6 %. (Covid19.ca.gov.)

22 The Presiding Judge has been in frequent communication with the Butte County Sheriff.
23 Despite a rigorous testing protocol at the jail, inmates are testing positive for COVID-19 at an increased
24 rate. On July 16, 2020, the Sheriff reported to the Presiding Judge that there were 29 asymptomatic
25 defendants who had tested positive for COVID-19. On July 19, 2020, the Sheriff reported to the
26 Presiding Judge that there were 71 positive COVID-19 cases in the jail. The population in the jail then
27 was 498. This population is in contrast to a pre-COVID average daily population of 562. The lowest
28 average was in May when it was 447. The jail is currently holding 70 inmates who have been sentenced
to CDCR, but those inmates cannot be sent to CDCR because CDCR is not accepting any intakes. As
of the date of this order, the Butte County Jail currently has 102 positive, in-custody inmate COVID-
19 cases. The current population of the jail is 468 inmates.

1 Despite the mitigation measures already in place, the Presiding Judge finds that the recent
2 dramatic increase in the rate of disease spread in the community and in the jail causes the Presiding
3 Judge to act to allow for increased mitigation measures. To that end, the Presiding Judge issues the
4 order below.

5 **II.**
6 **ORDER**

7 The countywide bail schedule remains as ordered on June 19, 2020 (See Third Amended Order
8 Rescinding the Emergency Jail Bail Schedule and Reinstating the Previously Existing Countywide Jail
9 Bail Schedule with Modifications BCSC 2020-AO-14-3A).

10 This court orders that the Butte County Sheriff may deviate from the countywide schedule and
11 follow the terms of the former Emergency Bail Schedule (See attached Second Amended Order
12 Adopting Emergency Jail Bail Schedule Pursuant to California Rules of Court, Emergency Rule 4
13 BCSC 2020-AO-14-2A) if needed at booking or any other stage of custody to mitigate the impact of
14 the coronavirus or COVID-19.

15
16 This authority shall continue in effect until rescinded or amended by order of the Presiding
17 Judge or, 90 days after the Governor declares that the state of emergency related to the COVID-19
18 pandemic is lifted, or until amended or repealed by the Judicial Council.

SECOND AMENDED ORDER ADOPTING
EMERGENCY JAIL BAIL SCHEDULE
PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA RULES OF
COURT, EMERGENCY RULE 4

10
11 On April 6, 2020, the Judicial Council of California adopted amendments to the California Rules
12 of Court, Appendix 1. Pursuant to California Rules of Court, Emergency Rule 4, and the provisions of
13 Penal Code section 1269b(c) and (d), the attached Amended Emergency Jail Bail Schedule for Offenses
14 Committed Within the County of Butte was adopted by Butte County Superior Court on April 13, 2020
15 and amended on April 14, 2020. This order and bail schedule supersede and existing orders and/or bail
16 schedules.

17
18 Under the Emergency Jail Bail Schedule, bail for all misdemeanor and felony offenses must be
19 set at \$0, with the exception of only the offenses listed below:

- 20 (1) A serious felony, as defined in Penal Code section 1192.7(c), or a violent felony, as
21 defined in Penal Code section 667.5(c);
22 (2) A felony violation of Penal Code section 69;
23 (3) A violation of Penal Code section 166(c)(1);
24 (4) A violation of Penal Code section 136.1 when punishment is imposed under section
25 136.1(c);
26 (5) A violation of Penal Code section 262;
27 (6) A violation of Penal Code sections 243(e)(1) or 273.5;

- 1 (7) A violation of Penal Code section 273.6 if the detained person made threats to kill or
2 harm, has engaged in violence against, or has gone to the residence or workplace of, the
3 protected party;
4 (8) A violation of Penal Code section 422 where the offense is punished as a felony;
5 (9) A violation of Penal Code section 646.9;
6 (10) A violation of an offense listed in Penal Code section 290(c);
7 (11) A violation of Vehicle Code sections 23152 or 23153;
8 (12) A felony violation of Penal Code section 463; and
9 (13) A violation of Penal Code section 29800.

10
11 Nothing in the Emergency Jail Bail Schedule restricts the ability of the court to deny bail as
12 authorized by article I, section 12, or 28(f)(3) of the California Constitution.
13

14 The adopted schedule was effective April 13, 2020 at 5:00 p.m., and continue in effect until 90
15 days after the Governor declares that the state of emergency related to the COVID-19 pandemic is lifted,
16 or until amended or repealed by the Judicial Council.
