Requirements for Minor Marriage

- Enclosed are the **Request of Minor to Marry (form FL-910)** and **Order on Request of Minor to Marry (form FL-915)** which must be completed and filed with the Court. Also enclosed are the forms which are to be completed and presented at the time of the Family Court Services Investigation Interview appointment. Parent(s) must accompany the couple to sign the consent form and be present for the Family Court Services Investigation Interview.
- After the application has been approved by a Superior Court Judge, a certified copy of the Order will be mailed to the applicant. The applicant shall present the Order to the Butte County Recorder's Office for issuance of a marriage license. Both parties need to be present to sign the marriage license. Parents do not need to be present.

Listed below are items applicant must present at the interview with the Family Court Services Investigator:

1. The minor must have a copy of his/her birth certificate.
2. The intended spouse must have a picture ID (Driver's License).
3. If the minor is pregnant, she must provide a statement from her physician giving expected due date.
4. If the minor is a ward/dependent of the Court, he/she must submit a letter from his/her probation officer or social worker.
5. If either party has been previously married, they must submit a copy of the Judgment of Dissolution.
6. The couple must have a letter (preferably on letterhead stationary) from a minister or counselor stating that they have had a minimum of one hour of pre-marital counseling.
7. If the minor's parents are divorced, a copy of the custody agreement or custody order must be submitted. The custodial parent of the minor is the parent that must appear and sign consent.
