
6 **ORDER**

7 This Order is intended to reconfirm the Court’s prior order of August 27, 2020, and
8 clarify and identify specifically that no person may enter any Butte County Court Facility whether by
9 public access, employee access, inmate transport, or any other means without a properly worn mask.
10 Further, that having received a COVID-19 vaccine does not relieve any individual of the duty to comply
11 with this Order.

13 Masks must be worn in the Courtrooms, and at any other location within Court facilities,
14 at all times consistent with this Order and other provisions of State Law¹. Convenience of counsel, the
15 court, a witness, juror, or any other participant or spectator does not meet the criteria for an exception.

17 Enforcement of this Order may be made through Penal Code section 166 or California
18 Code of Civil Procedure sections 1209-1222.
