at all times consistent with this Order and other provisions of State Law ¹ . Convenience of counsel, th	9
court, a witness, juror, or any other participant or spectator does not meet the criteria for an exception	
Enforcement of this Order may be made through Penal Code section 166 or Californ	a
Code of Civil Procedure sections 1209-1222.
